

We are sending this newsletter to provide an update on the development of our Des Sources Wind Project located in the Municipalities of Danville, Saint-Georges-de-Windsor and Wotton. Throughout the development phase of the project, we are being assisted by Québec firm Plan A Capital.

Project Update

In September 2023, we announced the decision not to submit a proposal as part of the Hydro-Québec 2023 Call for Tenders. The response timeline, being the shortest in the history of Québec's wind energy procurements, was not sufficient to provide stakeholders with enough time to properly review the project. Since then, we have continued pre-feasibility and consultation work, in preparation for the next Hydro-Québec Call for Tenders, which has not yet been announced. This work includes discussions with landowners in the study area, installation of wind measurement equipment, and meetings with stakeholders and potential community partners.

During the period between now and the next proposal to Hydro-Québec, we will continue to develop the project. This work includes feasibility engineering, environmental and technical studies to inform the overall design of the project. We are also planning additional stakeholder meetings, newsletters, and a second public open house. Our consultation efforts will continue through the life of the project, if we are selected by Hydro-Québec, as part of the following project schedule:
